Understanding the Registry Physician Self-Register Instructions


The Medical Marijuana Use Registry (Registry) is connected to the Department of Health, Division of Medical Quality Assurance (MQA). The information entered in Steps 4-9 is used to verify with MQA that you are authorized to access the Registry as a Qualified Physician.

Step 1: Open your internet browser (we recommend using Google Chrome) and navigate to the Medical Marijuana Use Registry at https://mwuregistry.FLHealth.gov.

Step 2: Click "Log In."



Step 3: Click "Register."




Step 4: Choose your profession from the drop-down menu.

Step 5: Enter your medical license number. (Use all capital letters with no spaces or dashes, for example ME12345.)

Step 6: Enter your last name exactly as it is registered with MQA.

Step 7: Enter your first name exactly as it is registered with MQA.

Step 8: Enter your 8-digit date of birth (mm/dd/yyyy).




Step 9: Enter the last 4 digits of your Social Security Number (SSN).

Step 10: Click "Verify Me."

Important note: If there are issues with verifying yourself, please contact MQA Licensure Support Services at MQAOnlineService@FLHealth.gov to ensure your information is accurately reflected on your medical license.

Step 11: When you have been verified, you will be taken to a screen where you can create a username and enter your email address. Click "Submit" after entering your Login ID and email address.



Step 12: Your registration for the Registry is complete. Click "Go Back to Log In Page" to return to the log in screen.



Important note: Your login credentials, including a temporary password for your initial login, will be emailed to you immediately after completing this step and you can begin using the Registry. For instructions on logging in for the first time, <u>click here</u>.
